

Awards Presented in 2019

Samuel Armour Award, presented to **Gale Fewings** for 20 years of developing and delivering outstanding curriculum-based programs at Hutchison House Museum that have engaged students in the region's history.

F.H. Dobbin Award, presented to **Rosemary McConkey** for her contributions to local history through the publication of several family histories and related works over numerous years, which provide a valuable record of the region and resource for researchers.

Martha Kidd Award, presented to **David Nelson** for his tireless promotion and successful achievement over 41 years on Peterborough County Council, and 15 years on Lang Pioneer Village Museum Advisory Committee, of championing the preservation of local built and cultural heritage.

J. Hampden Burnham Award, presented to the **students of Hist. 3351A, Trent University** for the development of an Online Museum Project on Peterborough and the First World War. The project involves the research, writing, formatting and creation of virtual exhibits that are posted and freely accessible, representing innovative curriculum and a valuable public resource for local history.

George A. Cox Award, presented to **Trent University** for the Bata Library renovation and rehabilitation, which carefully respected the architectural integrity, interior and exterior, of the original Ron Thom structure and concept.
